

**Summary of Proposed Changes to the Constitution of the PrimeTime Business and Professional Women's Association
for AGM held on 14 May 2026.**

5.1.3	<p>Honorary membership may be granted by the Board at its discretion. The term of an honorary membership is one year, and Board approval will be required for any renewal. The honorary member will be informed in advance including the reason, term and rights.</p>	<p>For paragraph 5.1.3 to be deleted.</p>	<p>Honorary membership creates confusion in membership count and voting rights, as Honorary membership does not have voting rights.</p> <p>The only member to have ever been conferred Honorary membership is founding president - Ms Juanita Woodward. Juanita has expressed that she does not wish to be an Honorary member and would prefer to have Ordinary membership. Juanita is therefore currently registered both as an Honorary member and Ordinary member of PrimeTime, creating a double count in membership and ambiguity on voting rights.</p> <p>As the purpose and intent of Honorary membership is unclear and results in unnecessary confusion and ambiguity. The Board proposes that this category of membership be abolished.</p>
